The London Yizkor Project is a unique project of remembrance, linking Londoners, both past and present with their family members who were murdered in the Shoah (the Holocaust).

Initiated by the late Lois Wiener Lowe and Danny Lowe in the 1980s, the LYP has continued to be developed and expanded over the years by a dedicated group of volunteers.

The rationale for the LYP reminds us that over time, memories fade and family records and stories may not be passed on to younger generations. By taking the time to think through these steps now, it is likely that additional (new) information or 'survivor stories' may be retrieved.

You may have already completed these forms some time ago- but we are requesting that you do it again in this electronic format.

These forms can be completed on your home computer and are immediately linked on a secure website.

However, if you wish to have these forms emailed to you or wish assistance with the completion of these forms, please contact a committee member (listed at the end of this letter)

There are three steps to this new process.

1. Complete the first form- a LYP data form for each Londoner, past or present. Names of children who were born or have lived in London can be entered onto the same form. You can upload any pdf documents/Word documents/Excel files/photos to this form.

2. Create a family list of relatives who perished in the Shoah.



3. Complete the second form, a Page of Testimony (a replica of the Yad Vashem Page of Testimony form), for each relative. You are encouraged to list as many names as possible, even if you have scant information. [Baby Gilbert, infant aged about 9 months of Michael Gelbert in Warsaw, 1942: or Sara Schwam, about 7 years old in Lodz, daughter of Naomi Schwam] Information like this example is useful information to add to the Page of Testimony form.

The Pages of Testimony will be forwarded to Yad Vashem.

By completing this process, your London family data is forever linked with the names of your family entered on the Pages of Testimony at Yad Vashem.

If you have previously submitted names to Yad Vashem, and are able to resubmit this data, please complete a Page of Testimony for each deceased relative. You may have obtained new information about the fate of your relatives over the years.

This will ensure that the information on the Yad Vashem website [Central Database](#) is current.

At the top of this form are 2 headings: **Voices of Survivors** and **Holocaust Library**. Open those hyperlinks to learn more about the London community.
